Pre-National Level Exam is a practice test conducted for students to give an essence of the National Level Examinations. Hence no marks will be recorded for the same.

DATES AND TIME: Dates and time are pre-decided and CANNOT be modified or altered.

SCHOOL REQUIREMENT: Minimum 10–15 computers with Internet connection should be there.

NOTES:

- ✓ Schools have to ensure that on the day of NLE, Internet and electricity power supply is duly maintained.
- ✓ The minimum speed of internet should be 20 Mbps.
- ✓ For best view, download Google Chrome or Mozilla Firefox.
- ✓ Visit us at www.orangeeducation.in and click NLE and enter your Roll No. and Password.
- ✓ Students must bring their Admit Cards to the Examination Centre.
- ✓ Do not share your Roll No. and Password with any other student.

FEE: The enrolment fee for the NLE will be ₹ 150 for the **National Level Examination (NLE) online exam** per student. School shall collect ₹ 150 from each student per Online Test and ₹ 200 from each student per NLE book.

NLE ASSENT FORM: Participation of the students will be confirmed only after receiving the duly filled Assent Form (attached) along with the payment.

NOTE: After receiving the payment, National Level Examination (NLE) Book for students will be dispatched within 7 - 10 working days to the school through courier/post.

**Once the payment is collected from the student, provide them the Admit Cards.
Last date of NLE registration is 15th December.**

Rules & Regulations

NATIONAL LEVEL EXAMINATION FORMAT

- ❖ National Level Examination is a computer based exam conducted in the school computer lab under the supervision of school teachers.
- ❖ Students have to login on our portal www.orangeeducation.in, 5 minutes before the examination starts.
- ❖ Once the student logs in with the roll no. and password mentioned in admit card, the computer screen will be locked for a period of 60 minutes. All websites will be automatically blocked on the computer being used by the student during the exam period.

EXAMINATION PAPER FORMAT

- ❖ For **classes 1 to 5**, each examination paper contains **30 questions**, out of which 25 are based on Subject Knowledge & essential Academic Skills and 5 questions are based on Logical Reasoning.
- ❖ For **classes 6 to 8**, each examination paper contains **40 questions**, out of which 32 are based on Subject Knowledge & essential Academic Skills and 8 questions are based on Logical Reasoning.
- ❖ For **classes 9 & 10**, each examination paper contains **50 questions**, out of which 40 are based on Subject Knowledge & essential Academic Skills and 10 questions are based on Logical Reasoning.
- ❖ English examination papers are based only on Subject Knowledge and essential Academic Skills only.

PRACTICE MATERIAL

- ❖ Grade appropriate National Level Examination (NLE) Book will be provided to the students for preparation of the examination.
- ❖ Practice Papers will be given to each student for online practice at home.

RANKING ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

In case of a tie at the National Level, preference will be given to the student as per the following criteria:

- ❖ **Negative marking:** $\frac{1}{2}$ mark will be deducted for every wrong answer during the final examination.
- ❖ **Time Frame Limitation:** Student who has submitted the online examination earlier than others will be given a rank preference.

RESULT

- ❖ The results of the National Level Exam will be declared jointly by the expert committee in the last week of February on our website.
- ❖ The result declared will be considered final.
- ❖ **Student Achievement and Analytical Report (SAAR)** will be given to each participating student.
- ❖ **School Performance and Analytical Report (SPAR)** will be given to each participating school.
